

# TIPS TO START YOUR HOLIDAYS IN THE BALEARIC ISLANDS

## ■ CURRENCY

The local currency is the EURO (€). You can exchange money at banks or currency exchange offices if needed.

## ■ WATER

Tap water is not drinkable. It is recommended to always drink bottled water.

## ■ CLIMATE

The Balearic Islands have a continental Mediterranean climate, with temperatures ranging from 16–18°C in winter to an average of 30°C in summer, though these can vary depending on whether you're in mountainous or coastal areas. Summers are humid, so we recommend packing light, breathable clothing.

## ■ SUN PROTECTION

Using sunscreen is especially recommended in the Balearic Islands. It's also important to protect your eyes with sunglasses, and to wear hats or caps. We suggest wearing light and comfortable clothing.

## ■ DISCOVER THE BALEARIC ISLANDS

Ask our representative about the best spots to visit on each island, and the possibility of exploring other islands in the Balearic archipelago.

## ■ DEPARTURE TRANSFER PICK-UP TIMES
