## ■ MONEY

The local currency is the "Peso Dominicano" (RD\$). In tourist areas, prices are often shown in US dollars (\$). Your representative will guide you to convert your currencies efficiently. Please note that exchange rates may vary daily.

## ■ BOX FORT

For the safety of your valuables, we strongly recommend that you use the safe in your hotel room.

## ■ WATER

Be careful, tap water is not safe to drink!

## ■ DEPARTURE

Your representative will inform you about the departure formalities and the time you will be picked up during the meeting the day after your arrival.  
Be sure to attend this session with your travel documents.

## ■ CLIMATE

In the Caribbean, a changeable microclimate prevails, making weather forecasts unreliable. It is difficult to predict the weather, even for the next few days.

## ■ OFFERS AT THE HOTEL

They will probably offer you various benefits at the hotel and try to convince you to join a briefing that is not ours.

Due to previous scams, we recommend that you wait to meet with your representative before engaging with someone.

During this meeting, you will receive all the information you need to optimise your holiday, saving you time and avoiding possible scams.
